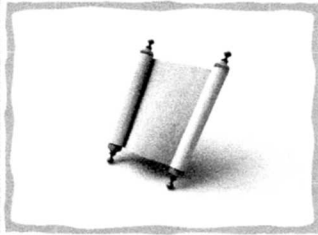

HEBREW/GREEK DEFINITIONS



- 1 **BEGAT** (3205) "yalad" - to bear young, to bring forth a child
- 2 **CONTINUALLY** (no number) Lit. All the days
- 3 **GIANTS** (5303) "nephyl" - a feller; ie. a bully or tyrant; used twice, Num.13:33 (5307) the fallen ones.
- 4 **REPENT** (5162) "nacham" - by imp. To be sorry, to have pity, also to avenge. To comfort ones self, to repent.
- 5 **STRIVE** (1777) "diyn" - to rule, To judge, contend.

10 GENERATIONS OF ADAM

- **ADAM** begat Seth at age 130, lived to 930 years.
- **SETH** begat Enos at 105 years, lived to 912 years.
- **ENOS** begat Cainan at 90 years, lived to 905 years.
- **CAINAN** begat Mahalaleel at 70 years, lived to 910 years.
- **MAHALALEEL** begat Jared at 65 years, lived to 830 years.
- **JARED** begat Enoch at 162 years, lived to 962 years.
- **ENOCH** begat Methuselah at 65 years, at 365 years God took him.
- **METHUSALEH** begat Lamech at 187 years, lived to 969 years.
- **LAMECH** begat Noah at 182 years, lived to 777 years.
- **NOAH** was 500 years old and begat Shem, Ham and Japheth.

1. When did men begin to call upon the name of the Lord? Gen. 4:26
 - One would assume this to be a positive reaction. What does the Bible teach concerning many who call upon His name? Matt. 7:21-23; Luke 6:46
 - When did these descendants begin to depart from the ways of the Lord? Gen. 6:2; Deut. 7:3-4
 - How many actually found favor in God's sight? 5:23; 6:8
2. In Genesis 6:3, what is meant by, "My spirit shall not always strive (1777) with man?" Deut. 32:35-36; I Sam. 2:9-10; Ps. 7:8-9
 - J.P. Green's original Hebrew text translates: "...in their erring, he is flesh. And his days shall be an hundred and twenty years." What does this imply? Ps. 78:39; 90:10
3. How great had the wickedness of man become? 6:5, 11
 - To what time is this compared? Mark 13:8-12, 19-20; 2 Pet. 2:5-9
 - How do we respond to those who think we live in a time now that is no different than the rest of history? 2 Pet. 3:4
4. How can it be that the Lord "repented (5162) he made man"? I Sam. 15:11, 29; Is. 46:9-10; Malachi 3:15
5. What is the spiritual significance of the flood? I Pet. 3:20-21; 2 Pet. 3:5-7
6. Why hasn't the final Judgment happened yet? Mk. 13:10; 2 Pet. 3:8-12
7. The Bible refers to itself as a "Book of Generations." What is the significance of these "generations"? Ps. 78:8; Luke 3:7; Matt. 12:39; Co. 1:26; I Peter 2:9
