BY FAITH ABRAHAM

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A BIBLICAL STUDY of Genesis 21-22

"Accounting that God was Able to Raise Him Up Even From the Dead"

In chapter 20, Abraham feared he would be slain by Abimelech because of Sarah. In chapter 21-22 Abraham trusted God, even if it meant the slaying of his only begotten son. What can be learned about this kind of faith?

- 1. Read Genesis 21:1-21. When did Abraham receive his son? 21:2
 - A. Throughout scripture, we read of the "set" or "appointed" time that God moves to make His will known. In Isaiah 55:11 we read, "It (my word) shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please..."
 - 1) Which attribute of God does this describe? Is. 46:9-10
 - 2) How is the next "appointed" time described? Acts 17:31
 - B. Read Genesis 22:1-19. List the ways in which Abraham demonstrated amazing obedience throughout this time. Gen. 21: 2, 3, 12-14; Gen. 22:3, 9-10
 - Notice the Hebrew definition of "obeyed" in Genesis 22:18. How is this type of obedience possible? Proverbs 20:12
 - 2) "Obey", "hear," "hearing" and "hearken" all have the same number (H8085), each representing the spiritual ear. Differentiate between those who have these "ears to hear" and those who don't. Ez. 12:2; Matt. 12:14-17; Acts 26:26-28
- 2. What are the characteristics of the faith of Abraham? Was it really Abraham's faith that saved him?
 - A. Hebrews 11:17-19
 - B. Galatians 3:6-9, 22; 2:16
 - C. Romans 4:22, 28
 - D. John 15:16
- 3. What is the necessary component of this faith? James 2:19-21, 26
 - What comes first?
- 4. RESPOND: In the Parable of the Laborers, the question proposed in the eleventh hour was, "Why stand ye here all the day idle?" (Matt. 20:6) Are we not in the eleventh hour? Is there an option in salvation that does not include works?
- 5. RESPOND: Why do people assume that works are of a "Tommy-do-good" or a "Dudley-do right" type person is the work of a believer?
 - What is the "work" that is expected from a child of God? Matt. 28:19-20; Ro. 10:14-15
 - Discuss the importance of beginning by reading the gospel: Ro. 10:17
 - Where does this work begin? Deut. 6:4-8
