

## HEBREW/GREEK DEFINITIONS

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- ADAM (120) "adam" the man, human being. The J.P. Green translation does not use "adam" as a name until Gen. 4:25.
- 2 HEARKEN (8085) "shama" to hear intelligently, with attention and/or obedience. Same Hebrew number used for the word "hearing."
- 3 LABOUR (5999) "amal" a wearing effort, hence worry, whether body or mind; grievance. Troublesome work.
- 4 SORROW (6093) "itstsawbone" - worrisomeness; ie.labor or pain. Used twice, Genesis 3:16a ,17
- 5 SORROW (6089) "ehtseb" an earthen vessel, usually a painful toil. Used twice, in Gen. 3:16b and Prov. 10:22.
- 6 SORROW (Greek 3077) sadness as in Jn. 16:20-22, II Corin. 7:10
- 7 SWEAT (2188) perspiration; Used only once, Gen 3:19
- 8 THORN (6975) thorn, a pricking; same in Hebrew and Greek. Compare to Matt. 13:22

A BIBLICAL STUDY - Genesis 3:14-20

"WHAT PROFIT HATH A MAN OF ALL HIS LABOUR?"

"Therefore I hated life because the work that is wrought under the sun is grievous unto me." The burden of life was even experienced by King Solomon, the wisest and most richest man. Do we make life a burden or is this the curse passed down to all mankind? What is the purpose of all our labor?

  - Notice when Adam gave the woman the name "Eve." (3:20) What is the spiritual significance to why she would not be given this name until after the fall?

- 3. What does the name "Adam" mean? Gen. 5:2 Why is all mankind guilty of the sin of Adam? I Cor. 15:22
- 4. Compare the consequences of Adam's sin and the connection to the following verses:
  - 1) Gen. 3:17 Compare to Prov. 10:22, Neh. 8:10b; John 16:22
  - 2) Gen. 3:18 Compare to Matt. 13:22
  - 3) Genesis 3:19 Compare to 2 Thess. 3:10; I Tim. 5:8
- Notice the similar definitions of sorrow (6093) and labour (5999). Is all our labor a continuation of the curse of Adam? Let us examine what the Bible teaches concerning labor.
